- 11. Installation of a permanent speed camera on the A468 at Lower Machen (Mar '21)
- 12. Bassaleg Bridge Issues (Aug '21)

Current Month updates:

Item 12. Bassaleg Bridge is still closed and will remain so until repairs have been carried out. The temporary entrance/exit into Forge Mews is causing traffic congestion as the traffic has been reduced to one lane on the approach to Bassaleg Roundabout and on the A467 until it passes the new opening.

Other Issues dealt with this month:

Cllr Tarr agreed to work with the neighbouring community council of Draethen, Waterloo and Rudry regarding the repair of the road bridge between the A468 and Draethen village.

Cllrs Williams and Jones are looking into why lanes on the J28 roundabout are closed off, as no work appears to be being carried out. The lane closures are causing issues on the roundabout itself and on the M4 where traffic is backing up into live lanes of the motorway at busy times.
