Current Month updates:

Items 7. Following information from Cllr Appleton regarding her speaking with the NCC Officer in charge of roundabout maintenance, Cllr Williams has been asked to lobby the Cabinet Member responsible for the Pont Ebbw, J 28 and Bassaleg roundabouts to resolve the issue of the roundabouts being handed over to NCC in such a poor state, normal maintenance cannot be performed by NCC officers.

Other Issues dealt with this month:

The Clerk has again reported the brambles, weeds and stinging nettles growing out of the bottom of the hedge on the Griffin which is now forcing pedestrians onto the road to avoid.

The Clerk is working with the neighbouring community council of Draethen, Waterloo and Rudry with keeping up momentum for both NCC and CCBC councils to repair the road bridge to Draethen from the A468.
