13. Bus stop on Laurel Road (2019)
14. Crash barrier outside the Ruperra Pub (2019)

### Current Month updates:

Items 13 & 14: These have been added to the list. Despite best efforts, both these items remain issues. NCC Officers have said the crash barrier repair is on a schedule and will be repaired in due course and as funding allows but it has been almost a year since that advice. The bus stop repair has been looked into by Cllr Tarr and City Cllrs Williams and Cornelious but it still remains broken.

Item 12: Bassaleg Bridge repairs are ongoing. They are likely to be completed sometime into the new year.

### Other Issues:

Cllr Tarr agreed to work with the neighbouring community council of Draethen, Waterloo and Rudry regarding the repair of the road bridge between the A468 and Draethen village.
