This report lists items which remain issues that are being monitored and progressed when possible. Items will only be removed once resolved. Any updates during the month will be detailed below the list.

1. Additional lighting on Laurel Road (Jan '14)

9. Overgrowth of residential boundary hedge alongside steps and footpath from Penylan Close to Caerphilly Rd Bassaleg. (Jan '19)
10. Bassaleg School proposed expansion (Oct '20)
11. Installation of a permanent speed camera on the A468 at Lower Machen (Mar '21)
12. Bassaleg Bridge Issues (Aug '21)
13. Bus stop on Laurel Road (2019)
14. Crash barrier outside the Ruperra Pub (2019)

Current Month updates:

Item 10. Council submitted a very comprehensive set of comments to the Planning Dept regarding the recently submitted application highlighting a number of issues. NCC's Planning Committee is due to deliberate in early February and an outcome is expected soon.

Item 12: Repairs to Bassaleg Bridge are progressing and the bridge is now safe for foot traffic. However, there will be no vehicular access for some time until the bridge pier can be permanently repaired. This cannot take place until better weather. In the meantime, temporary parking bays for Forge Mews residents have been made on the other side of the bridge and it is NCC's intention for residents to begin using them as an alternative. NCC will then close up the opening onto the A467 Northbound and remove bollards from the dual carriageway asap.
